TOURNAMENT

- 7 Round Swiss in 6 Sections: K-12 Championship, K-12 Under 1900, K-12
 Under 1600, K-12 Under 1200, K-12 Under 800, & K-12 Unrated
- Unrated players can only play in the Unrated or Championship sections
- Pairings online only
- Team score is total of top four finishers from each school per section

STUDENT / CHAPERONE BEHAVIOR

As a reminder, the CPS Chess Rules and Regulations and the CPS Code of Conduct cover sportsmanship at the National tournament. We expect that all students and adults adhere to the guidelines set forth by the Department of Academic Competitions and CPS. If students do not comply with the rules, we will ask that parents secure a ticket and travel to Baltimore to pick up their child and return home with them.

SPORTSMANSHIP

- A. Participant, coach, trainer or another attendant must not commit an unsportsmanlike act. This includes, but not limited to, acts or conduct such as:
- 1. Disrespectfully addressing an official, coach, or participant or gesturing in such a manner as to indicate resentment.
 - 2. Using profane or inappropriate language or gestures.
- 3. Baiting or taunting an opponent. Any form of taunting which is intended or designed to embarrass, ridicule, or demean others under any circumstances, including on the basis of race, religion, gender or national origin is disapproved.

PERMISSION FORMS

At recent tournaments there have been too many students running around inside the building and horseplaying at our tournaments. We expect Chicago Public Schools' students to be on their best behavior while representing the District at the US Chess High School Nationals. Chaperones should have signed copies of the <u>ACADEMIC CHESS</u>

PARENT PERMISSION FORM and BEHAVIOR AGREEMENT for each of the students with them on the trip.
